

Pediatric Emergency Medical Services Workshops



WHAT: Regional workshops to present the new concept of the Pediatric Emergency Care Coordinator, or PECC, designed to be a position included in every EMS agency in the country. The PECC would be the go-to person for all things pediatric at a particular EMS agency, including such tasks as protocol development, quality improvement, continuing education and skill verification, injury prevention, and liaison with the PECC at receiving hospital emergency departments. In addition, the workshops will include a breakout session on pediatric skill assessment.

WHY: This fall, the Ohio EMS for Children Program will conduct surveys of all Ohio EMS agencies, asking specifically about PECCs and pediatric skill assessment. In order to help agencies understand these Performance Measures, including expectations, Ohio EMS for Children will offer workshops in October and November 2017 at several locations statewide.
